Treasurer's Report:

--Treasurer's Report was presented by John Brown.
Total Cash - \$4486.28: including Savings account, \$1003.15; Checking account, \$936.12; CD account, \$2547.01.

-- One new member paid dues and attended the meeting.

Old Business:

- - A Raffle was initiated that included a rod/reel combo and various jigs. Raffle drawing was held at the end of the meeting.
- - NAC T-shirts were being sold at the meeting.
- - Members were asked to give John Brown a copy of all citations when received. Also a sheet showing the current members leading in hooking citation fish was posted.
- -The Annual Club Challenge was discussed in detail. NAC will participate in the annual Challenge tournament on August 22; Captain's meeting will be hold on the 21st. John Brown stated that the Club prepaid \$300 for 5 boats owned by club members to participate in the Challenge. Sign up sheets were provided for boat captains and crew members. All participants are required to be an active member of the club. Lucian stated that a meeting would be schedule to match the crews with the boat captains and the fish species to target.
- -Lucian summarized the success of the St Jude Regatta Fishing tournament.

New Business:

- -Consider having a future NAC Meeting at Princess Anne Distributors. Anthony of Princess Anne Distributors asked that our Club hold its October meeting at his location. After the meeting he would give all attendees a discount on all floor items in the

store. The President asked for a show of hands and a majority of active members agreed to hold the October meeting at Princess Anne.

- -Club Social

Fishing Reports:

--Billy Rellos and Louis Glaser discussed the excellent flounder fishing trips during the past few weeks along the CBBT using jigs with cut bait, and traditional flounder rigs. Most fish were in the 2 – 5 pounds class. John Brown said the Cobia bite was on.

Guest Speaker:

- - Mike Firestone discussed the tackle needed and how, when and where to caught Sheepshead. Bite from early June to mid-Oct. in and around the CBBT pilings and islands. Line should be 50 lbs test with 2 ft. fluorocarbon leader, an in-line egg sinker, and a 3/0 hook. Current should be slow. Choice bait is fiddler crabs and chowder clams. Drop bait to various depth until you get a bite.
- - Club appreciated Mike's knowledge and experience and gave him an NAC T-shirt.
