Old Business:

Attendees were reminded about the Club Challenge tournament on August 21th. Crew members on the 5 boats have been selected.

Veterans Fishing Trip On September 18th the second Veterans trip will be held at Vinings Marina at Taylors Landng. The trip was organized by the NAC. Captain Will Bransom will head the trip and meet with Military officials to get a veterans' count. A picnic will happen after the trip. Again fried fish caught and donated; and hamburgers, hot dogs and other food provided by the military will be on the menu.

Speckle Trout Tournament for Club members only will be held on November 6th. The tournament winners will be determined by boat not individual caught. A Picnic will follow the tournament. Each participant will pay \$10 to fish and \$5 for the picnic.

Special Tanks and Appreciation:

The Club wants to get a special thanks to Bill Kelly (Wild Bill) for donating a speaker system to the club for use during its monthly meetings.

Fishing Reports: Many members provided details about their recent fishing trips. Many flounder were caught by Chris, Louis (over 10 lber), JB, Fletcher, and Taz; AJ citations by the crew on the Fishin Fool at the South Tower, Cobia and Reds along the CBBT by Neal.

Guest Speaker: Captain Carolyn Brown (The Big Craft) discussed bait, weather, tides, and methods for catching flounder with live bait. To catch bait (spot and croaker) she drifts in shallow water in Lynnhaven with 4 rods in the holders. She uses 1 oz, #8 long shank hooks. Favorite depth for flounder fishing is 40 to 45 feet with 3/0 Laser Eagle Claw hooks. She said that the secret to catching more fish is to fish more.

A raffle was held at the conclusion of the meeting to win donated fishing items.
