Guest Speaker: Capt. Skip Feller talked about deep drop fishing for blueline tile, golden tile, and grouper. Blueline like slab rock bottom in 300 ft or more of water; golden like muddy bottom in deeper water and grouper like hard rocky bottom in deep water. Uses 2 speed reels (5.2 high, 2.3 low gear) and Power pro 80 lb when bait dropping. Uses 200 lb test mono on 2 speed reels when jigging with 500 gram jigs. Uses all color jigs. Mono is used for jigging because untangling lines created by inexperienced clients is easier.
