Old Business:

Lucian Montagna thanks all the volunteers that helped make the October 9th Social very successful. Crabs, Oysters, Clams, BBQ Butts, and Turkey were served at the picnic, as well as side dishes and drinks. The turnout was excellent.

The September 18th Veterans Fishing Trip sponsored by the NAC was cancelled due to the bad weather.

New Business:

Member only Speckled Trout Tournament: There was extensive discussion about the November 6th NAC members only Speckled Trout Tournament. A 6:30 PM Captain's meeting will be held at Ships Cabin. Cost to participate is \$15 per boat captain, \$15 per each addition person on the boat; 1st 2nd and 3rd place winners for heaviest 3 aggregate fish. After lunches are bought the remaining proceeds will go to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. All anglers can participate in a \$15 per person Calcutta. All proceeds will go to the 1st place (80%) and 2nd place (20%) winners in the Calcutta. Lines in at 7:30AM and weigh-in between 3:30 and 4PM. Picnic included drinks and subs.

Members only Striper Fishing Tournament: This tournament is scheduled for December 18th. More information will come at next month's meeting.

Open Speckled Trout Tournament: NAC and Top Rack Marina are hosting an open speckled trout tournament on January 15th, 2011. While all the details are not final, a large pay-out is expected based on a 3 fish aggregate: 1st - \$1500, 2nd - \$500, 3rd - \$300, 4th - \$200, 5th – Minn Kota Trolling Motor. Calcutta payout will be 80% for 1st and 20% for 2nd, largest fish. A Junior Angler Award will be presented. Also there will be Silent Auctions and Raffles to bid on. The tournament will be held at Top Rack Marina on the Elizabeth River in Chesapeake. A banquet will follow the fish weigh-in. Over 30 businesses are sponsoring this event and we are anticipating a large turn-out of anglers. More details can be found at www.icwspeckledtroutshootout.com.

Guest Speakers:

Captain Max King provided his vast experiences in the art of catching trophy stripers in the Chesapeake Bay and inshore Ocean. Max shared his techniques on using cut baits (chunking) between October and November and using eels for large stripers after Thanksgiving through December in the Bay when the water is in the mid-fifties. He uses a 7/0 Octopus hook (black or red but not silver) on 50lb flora carbon. The size of the eels are between 12 to 16 inches. Free lining with no weight and down lining with ½ to 1oz barrel sinking are the preferred methods for eeling. At about 42 degrees the striper bite stops and the fish leave the Bay area.

A raffle was held at the conclusion of the meeting to win donated fishing items.
